Managing contractor appointed for Port Lincoln Hospital redevelopment

Mossop Construction + Interiors have been appointed the managing contractor for the \$39.2 million Port Lincoln Hospital redevelopment.

This funding is being provided by the Australian Government through the Health and Hospitals Fund.

Mossop Construction + Interiors has also been appointed managing contractor for construction of the \$800,000 State-funded dialysis unit and the \$500,000 Australian Government-funded chemotherapy unit which will be built concurrently at the hospital.

Michele Smith, Country Health SA Regional Director for the Eyre, Flinders and Far North, said enabling works would start on the site in April 2013 with the redevelopment expected to be completed in November 2014.

“The redevelopment of Port Lincoln Hospital will enable more people to have their treatments locally, reducing the need for them to travel to Adelaide,” she said.

“The redevelopment will include a refurbished integrated operating theatre suite and a new 20 bed ward.

“The new ward will include a six bed inpatient mental health unit and will see the existing shared facilities replaced with single rooms with ensuite bathrooms.

“There will be 1425m² of new construction for community health services and 324m² of new construction for allied health services, including seven public dental chairs on site.

“The ground floor entrance area will be refurbished with new stairs and a ramp and there will also be a 50 bay car park.

“The new dialysis and chemotherapy unit will include four renal chairs and four chemotherapy chairs located in a refurbished existing building.”

Ms Smith said the new 20 bed ward would replace the existing Flinders ward.

Mossop Construction + Interiors are now inviting Registrations of Interest from subcontractors with proven experience in a number of trades.

Registrations of Interest close at 5pm on Tuesday 26 March.

“We would encourage subcontractors with proven experience from Port Lincoln and the surrounding areas in particular to apply,” Grant Mossop from Mossop Construction + Interiors said.

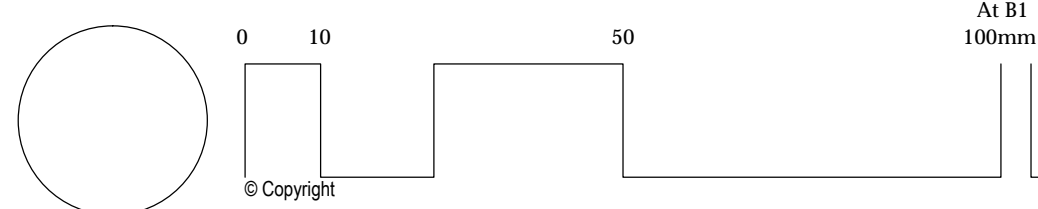
